NONPROFITS AT WORK

1 in 7 North Dakota private sector workers is **employed** by a **nonprofit**.

*That's more than **54,000** North Dakota workers.*



Nonprofits pay **\$2.6 billion** in annual **wages**.

*North Dakota nonprofit wages make up **15%** of the state's private sector **payroll**.*

Nonprofits employ **more than twice** as many North Dakotans as the state's **manufacturing industry**.

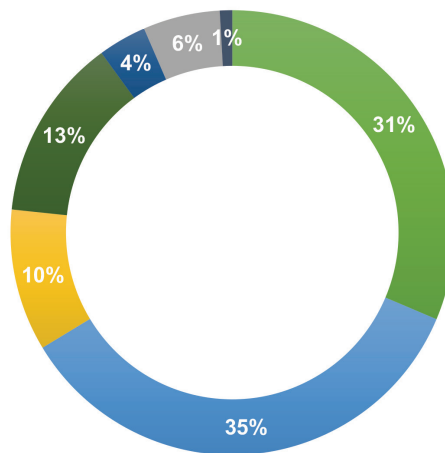
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NONPROFITS BY THE NUMBERS

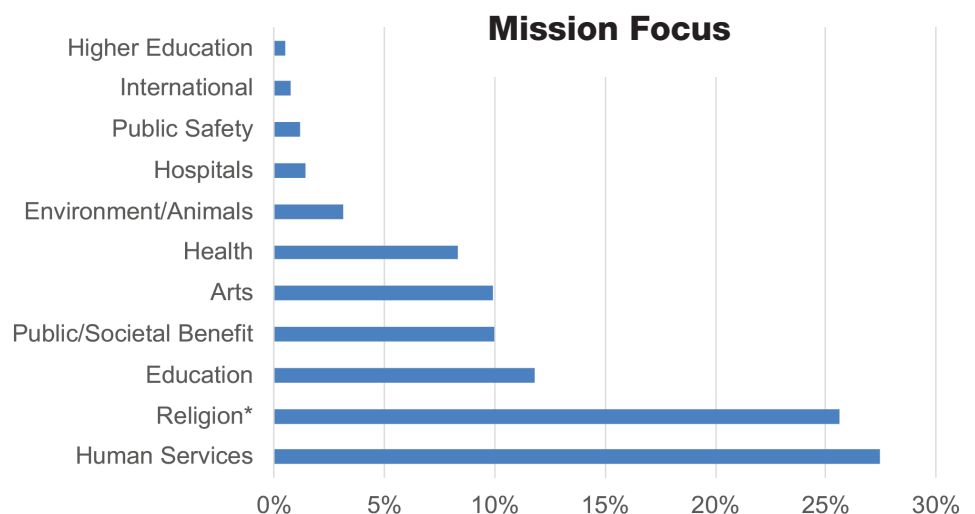
Annual Revenue

This report focuses on **public charities** in North Dakota. Public charities (3,712), along with private foundations (166), are classified by the IRS as **501(c)(3)** organizations and are eligible to receive tax deductible contributions. Other nonprofits (1,937) include fraternal organizations and trade associations. Not accounted for in these numbers are religious congregations, which are 501(c)(3) organizations but not required to report to the IRS.
